> These two train tunnels at Zhunan, Miaoli was built in Japanese Colonial Era. It is the only dual rail tunnel consists of two consecutive passages in Taiwan. During WWII, one of them was strafed by bombers on its wall. Along with electrification and rearrangement of railway network, now these tunnels are only heritages once evidencing economic development

of early years of Taiwan. Railway in use nowadays is dozens meter from here and nearer to the sea. Hence, trains might pass by while touring the place. On the top of tunnels through

trail, windmills at seaside could be seen.

Yingge is known for its pottery, so "Yingge Old Street" is also known as the Pottery Old Street. The history of pottery craft has lasted for over 200 years, and is a major pottery township throughout the country reputed as the "Jingde Village" of Taiwan. The entire street is filled with pottery and porcelain related crafts and works, thick in cultural arts. Here you can stroll along the streets and pick out the favorite pottery works of art, or personally experience the fun of pottery making. Besides clay molding and throwing, there are also many authentic cuisines in Yinnge Old Street and its surroundings.

> Shilin Night Market is the one of the largest night markets in Taipei. The market is centered on Yangming Theater and Cicheng Temple. The night market is formed by many prosperous shops on Wenlin Road, Dadong Road and Danan Road, etc. Among them, Shilin Market was built as early as in

1899 and the market is famous for various snacks and eatery. Many visitors have come to Shilin Night Market to enjoy the delicious foods, such as large pancake enfolding small pancake, hot pot on stone or Shilin sausage. Shilin Night Market has become a renowned place for great foods.

Located in the finest district Taipei has to offer, Taipei 101 is the largest engineering project ever in the history of the Taiwan construction business. Supported by a dozen or so domestic businesses, the TFC Corp. was fortunate to have local and international experts in charge of the planning, and world-class architect C.Y. Lee was responsible for the design of the project. The design transcends the uni-body concept and is based on the Chinese number 8, a numeral long considered lucky in Chinese culture. Eight-floor structural units are connected one by one on top of each other to form the whole. This kind of rhythmic aesthetic is new to skyscrapers.

XCreate funky articles with local indigo dye & hot pot for lunch

There is an open-front indigo-dyeing studio with

history/DIY-experience sessions offered. Before these days of synthetic dyes, hill indigo was an important regional commercial crop, with the Hakka front and center. Zhuo Ye also uses a range



of other natural dyes, all made on-site. Other amenities of the Zhuo Ye "village" complex (all available to non-guests) include a vegetarian restaurant and tea/beverage/snack bar with outdoor seating overlooking a placid duck pond, and a retail outlet displaying its fashionable natural-dye clothing.

1330-1430 · Shengxing Train Station

The Shengxing Train Station is located at the highest point of the western railway trunkline, 402.326 meters above sea level. The train station, completed in 1906, is built entirely of wood in the Japanese huya (lit. Teeth of a Tiger) style, which is supposed to ward off evil spirits.



Many artifacts from the Japanese occupation period can still be seen here, such as the old train signals that originally stood between the Shengxing and Tai-an Station, which were later replaced by a central control system.

1500-1600 · Sanyi Wood Sculpture Museum

The tradition of Taiwan wood sculpture derived from the same origins as the Fujianese and Cantonese during the dynasties of Ming and Ching.

Owing to abundant resource of camphor, Sanyi has become internationally famous as The City of Wood Sculpture. Originally regarded as Sanyi Wood Sculpture Arts Gallery, this museum was built by the Construction Department, Taiwan Provincial Government in March 1990 in its aim to promote the arts of wood sculpture.





1700 Hotel: Onsen Papawaga

The Onsen Papawaqa is a forceful work of modernist architecture directly overlooking the Wenshui riverbed.

Each room faces the river through floor-to-ceiling glass, with a window-side Japanese-style in-floor stone-slab tub. "The extensive public-area spa facilities are outside the main





building; there are separate nude bathing areas for males and females, a non-nude mixed bathing area, and a wonderful cool-temperature narrow swimming pool that runs the entire main building's length between building and riverside bluff-edge." The evening starry-sky viewing is scintillating.

1000-1130 · Penglai River Ecology Park

The Penglai River Ecology Trail in Nanjhuang is known for its rusticity and originality. This area is completely natural with only a few bridges made out of bamboo and simple rock and wooden steps. Alongside these paths are rich ecological resources--plants and animals, birds and insects. In the streams you can see unique



species of aquatic life such as the Ku hua (Varicorhinus barbatulus), Taiwan stone minnow (Acrossocheilus paradoxus), and Yi chi hua (Candidia barbata), making this a very special place for fascinating ecological tours.

1200-1330 · Nanzhuang Old Street (lunch on own)

The town of Nanzhuang is a popular Taiwan tourist stop for its abundant natural surroundings and its Nanzhuang Old Street filled with all kinds of Hakka and aboriginal snacks and delicacies, as well as Nanzhuang's most gifted natural resources: mushroom, Gui bamboo shoots and trout. There are a few stone tablets at the entrance of Nanzhuang Old Street that are remains of a place



where waters flows down from the mountains, allowing the villagers to come and do their daily laundries in the past.

The most famous alley of Nanzhuang Old Street is "Guihua Alley" that derives its name from a kind of flower associated with "Sweet Tea Olive". It is where one may find a number of small stands and shops for souvenirs and savor authentic Hakka delicacies.





1430-1530 · Houlung Cape of Good Hope

Houlong Cape of Good Hope is Icoated on a sea front hill. It overlooks ebbing and flowing, waves, an infinite ocean, and a coastal bay that spans for several kilometres. The sunrise and sunset at Houlong Cape of Good Hope are also well appreciated scenery.



Gazing out from the cape, you'll see layers and layers of verdant mountains sitting on one side and continuous clear bay on the other. What's more attracting, is the row of gigantic wind farms lining the bay, shining white under the clear blue sky, with trains passing sporadically. There is also a centuries old stone weir, the Pingpu Tribe's cultural heritage, at Cape of Good Hope, which was a traditional fishing device for aborigine tribes.

1630-1730 · Gaomei Wetlands

Gaomei Wetland located on the south of the mouth of Dajia River is a land mixed with both sand and soil textures and comes in 1,500 acres. That explains why it has complicated yet rich wetland ecology and possesses the largest group of Bolboschoenus planieulmis in Taiwan. Due to diverse



geographical features, the species of its ecology is quite abundant. Every year around fall and winter, large flocks of migrating birds would come here for either short or long stay over the winter, serving as the best spot for bird-watching.

to enjoy beautiful views of the Sun Moon Lake from the top.

> Taiwan's largest lake, Sun Moon Lake is located in the mountains of Nantou at the geographic centre of Taiwan island.

The name of the lake is inspired by the beauty of the area. The east side of the lake is round, like the sun, while the west side is long and narrow, like a crescent moon.



· Anping Old Fort

A combined Dutch military and commercial force captured modern day Anping in 1624, and built Fort Zeelandia as its defensive stronghold, which was completed in 1634.

The fort was rebuilt after the Japanese Colonial Period, and renamed Anping Old Fort after World War II. Today the only



remnant of the Dutch period is the southern brick wall outside the front gate of the Old Fort, covered in the tangled roots of old banyan trees, evidence of the nearly 400 years of Taijiang's history. In 1975, as part of the Tainan City Government's "sightseeing year" project, Anping Old Fort was repaired and its grounds extended. A pointed roof was also added to the observation tower, and the wall was painted white; that is the Anping Old Fort that we see today.

· Beimen Visitor Center · Crystal Church

Beimen Visitor Center is housed in a refurbished warehouse on the southwest side of the old Beimen Salt Washing Factory. There is no way of missing the minimalist Crystal Church near Beimen Visitor Center. Its exterior combines the flowing curves of the Sydney Opera House and the pristine clarity of the



wedding chapel on Guam. Sparkling crystals are set into the white steel ribs rising from the shallow waters of the salt field.

· Jing Zhai Jiao Tile Paved Salt Fields

Jing Zhai Jiao Tile Paved Salt Fields were Beimen's first salt fields, and the oldest remains of tile paved salt fields in existence, and feature beautiful art made from salt tiles that resemble mosaics.



2002 saw the end of 338 years of thriving salt industry at Jing

Zhai due to the rising costs of labor, and the salt fields which used to cover this whole place were abandoned for a while. In order to revive the culture of the salt industry and breathe new life into the salt fields, the site has now been brought back to life as a distinctive scenic spot on Tainan's coast.
