Itinerary

Day1 Hotel→Luce Memorial Chapel→Lunch: Park Lane by CMP→Natural Way Six Arts Cultural Center→Shin Sei Green Waterway→Return to Taichung hotel.

0900 Departure.

0930-1100 · **Luce Memorial Chapel**

This campus is the most attractive one of all the universities in Taiwan. The buildings on the campus are modeled after the architectural style of the Tang dynasty. However, the landmark of Tunghai University is the church designed by I.M. Pei.



1130-1330 · **Park Lane by CMP (Lunch on your own)**

Upon your arrival at Park Lane by CMP, you will definitely notice the 20-meter tall vertical garden walls. The building was renovated from an abandoned parking lot by the CMP team with an intension to integrate the architecture with greeneries that surround. Based on a sense of respect to nature, Park Lane by CMP is designed to be an urban garden where modernity and nature coexist.



1400-1500 · **Natural Way Six Arts Cultural Center**

Built in 1937 in the Japanese Colonial Period, Natural Way Six Arts Center was a place for Japanese wardens and police officers to practice martial arts. Being the only well-preserved martial arts hall in Taichung, it is extremely valuable for historical, architectural studies and adaptive reuse.



1530-1730 · **Shin Sei Green Waterway**

The romantic dandelion lamps in Shin Sei Green Waterway. The area where you can walk and take pictures is about 600 meters, but the length of the green river is 6 kilometers. The waterfront of the Green River is located in front of the Taichung Railway Station, which is different from the atmospheric structure of the blue belt of the Yanchuan River. The Xinsheng Green River Waterway Corridor has a Japanese temperament line, which is comparable to the Kamo River in Kyoto, Japan and is known as the shore of the small Kyoto waterfront.



Where to go...

· **Miyahara Ophthalmology**

Situated nearby Taichung Train Station on the bank of Luchuan, Miyahara is a red-brick architecture built by Miyahara Takeo, a Japanese ophthalmology doctor in 1927. It was the largest ophthalmology clinic in Taichung during the Japanese colonial





period. After the surrender of Japan in 1945, Miyahara became Taichung Health Bureau. Visitors to Miyahara are not only recommended to appreciate the details of the historic architecture but also try Dawn Cake's signature ice cream, bubble tea and pastries wrapped in nostalgic packings!
